This study is the first in Spain to evaluate the **actual impact of climate initiatives on business competitiveness**, encompassing small and medium-sized enterprises.

This report makes a key contribution to understanding how Spanish companies are addressing the climate transition, using a pioneering approach that not only measures the level of corporate climate action but also examines its relationship with competitiveness.

Based on a representative sample of 800 companies, the study provides a **comprehensive snapshot of sustainability strategies across different sectors and company sizes**, helping to identify barriers, opportunities, and climate action mechanisms.

The report serves as a **key reference** for governments, investors, and companies, offering data and recommendations to accelerate the climate transition through a pragmatic, evidence-based approach.

- **Guiding the implementation of policies and programs**, by providing incentives, instruments, and action frameworks tailored to each area of the climate transition, improving public spending effectiveness and alignment with private investment.
- **Accelerating on-the-ground climate action**, by connecting evidence, practical experience, and implementation capacity in key sectors, speeding up the adoption of solutions and generating real, measurable impact.


This report brings together the main conclusions of the working group led by **alinea** throughout 2025 to analyse the available financing instruments for building renovation and decarbonization.




Sector Insights






Exploratory Dialogues

These concise and targeted pieces capture the analyses and reflections emerging from exploratory dialogues that serve as a starting point for the development of alinnea's working groups. They contribute to shaping new narratives in the climate discourse, both in relation to alinnea's work and to broader issues on the climate agenda, such as the outcomes of the Conference of the Parties (COP) under the UNFCCC.

Their uses include:

- **Identifying emerging barriers and structural tensions** before they become entrenched in public or regulatory debates, enabling the early anticipation of strategic risks and opportunities.
- **Building shared analytical frameworks**, aligning diverse stakeholders around common diagnoses that facilitate future agreements, policies, and investment decisions.
- **Testing innovative narratives and approaches**, helping to renew the climate discourse and strengthen the legitimacy and feasibility of climate action.
- **Shaping future agendas for analysis and action**, guiding policymakers, companies, and financiers to focus time and resources where they can generate the greatest medium-term impact.






